

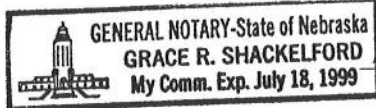

NOTICE

1. Pursuant to Title 291, Chapter 1, Rule 027.03A(5), defendant is hereby notified that the Commission has set a hearing date for this complaint on May 28, 1997, at 11:00 a.m. in the Commission Hearing Room, 300 The Atrium, 1200 "N" Street, Lincoln, Nebraska. Defendant is further notified that failure to file an answer to this complaint within twenty (20) days from the date of service will be construed as an admission of the allegations stated therein.

2. Failure by the defendant to file an answer or to appear at the hearing allows the Commission to (a) immediately enter an order assessing a civil penalty and additional penalties as provided for by law, or (b) to proceed with the hearing and receive evidence of the alleged violation(s) and thereby assess civil penalties and other relief as provided for by law.

3. Upon failure to pay any civil penalty determined by the Commission, such civil penalty unpaid shall constitute a debt to the State of Nebraska and be collectible by civil action in the District Court of Lancaster County.
