BY THE COMMISSION:

On the motion filed by the complainant in this matter on March 5, 1999, the Commission finds as follows:

Opinion and Findings

Complainant, Robert Logsdon, presented preliminary evidence that respondents listed in Exhibit 1 have failed to comply with the Commission rules and regulations concerning payment of fees. Specifically, complainant alleges:

1. Complainant is Director of the Department of Motor Transportation of this Commission.
2. Respondents are motor carriers certificated by the Public Service Commission to operate in the state of Nebraska.
3. On February 26, 1999, the complainant sent respondents a letter informing them of the requirements they must meet in order to be in full compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations.
4. Those requirements include the obligation of respondents to pay annual fees, under Neb. Rev. Stat., Section 75-305 (Reissue 1996), and Title 291, Chapter 3, Rule 004 et. seq. of the Nebraska Public Service Commission Motor Carrier Rules and Regulations.

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5. As of March 5, 1999, respondents have not paid their annual fees as required, therefore are not in compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations.

Accordingly, the Commission finds that the respondents should be ordered to show cause why the Commission should not (1) revoke respondents' Certificates of Public Convenience and Necessity, (2) order respondents to cease and desist from offering services as motor carriers in Nebraska pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat., Section 75-133 (Reissue 1996), and (3) order that the respondents remit any such fines authorized by law.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the Respondents, as listed in Exhibit 1, are hereby ordered to show cause why the Commission should not (1) revoke respondents Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity, (2) order respondents to cease and desist from offering services as motor carriers in Nebraska pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat., Section 75-133 (Reissue 1996), and (3) order that the respondents remit any such fines authorized by law.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the respondents personally appear before this Commission at a hearing in this matter in the Commission Hearing Room, 300 The Atrium, 1200 N Street, Lincoln, Nebraska, on March 30, 1999, at 11:00 a.m.
