OPINION AND FINDINGS

The Complainant filed this Complaint against Defendant alleging that the Defendant violated Neb. Rev. Stat. Sec. 75-309, and 75-117. in violation of Neb. Rev. Stat. § 75-309; for violating 75-126 by charging a rate for service that was not approved by the Commission; for violating 75-307 by not having a commercial liability insurance policy on file with the Commission; and for violations of 75-301 to 75-343 by operating as a transportation network company without complying with the requirements set forth in said statutes.

By Stipulation entered into between Complainant and Defendant on October 19, 2015, the Complaint filed herein against Defendant is to be dismissed with prejudice upon payment of a stipulated fine by the Defendant. The fine payment has been received, and the Commission therefore finds that the terms of the Stipulation have been satisfied and that the Complaint should be dismissed with prejudice.

The Commission further states that Lyft, Inc., while now in compliance with state statutes, must remain in compliance with all state and federal statutes and regulations over which the Nebraska Public Service Commission has jurisdiction in the future. The failure to do so can and will result in further legal action to be taken against them.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the Complaint in Docket No. MCC-3189, be, and is hereby, dismissed with prejudice.
