## BY THE COMMISSION:

On March 5, 2018, Jamie Reyes, Director of the Motor Transportation Department ("Complainant") filed a complaint against the above-captioned Respondents alleging violation of Neb. Rev. Stat. § 75-305 (Cum. Supp. 2016). Complainant alleges that Respondents failed to timely file the annual fees as required by § 75-305 by March 1, 2019. Complainant seeks an order revoking Respondents' Certificates of Public Convenience and Necessity and to require Respondents to cease and desist from offering services as motor carriers pursuant to § 75-133, and/or to assess any such fines authorized by law for failure to remit annual fees in compliance with § 75-305.

Subsequent to the Complaint, the following Respondents remitted the required annual fees to the Commission:

These Respondents have complied with § 75-305 by making the proper payments. As this was the first late renewal payment for these Respondents, each Respondent applied for and was granted a waiver of administrative fines. As such, staff recommends that the above-named Respondents should be dismissed from the Complaint. Respondents are on notice that failure to remit future annual fee payments in a timely manner could result in administrative fines and costs.

Additionally, the Commission received the renewal payment for Ford Storage & Moving Co. on March 5, 2019 with a postmark of February 28, 2019. Ford Storage & Moving Co. was granted a waiver for its late renewal payment last year and would not have been eligible for a waiver of any administrative fines for any subsequent year1; however, company representatives spoke with Commission staff regarding extenuating circumstances resulting in the renewal payment being postmarked prior to the March 1st deadline. Upon consideration of the circumstances, the Commission has determined that a waiver of administrative fines will be granted to Ford Storage & Moving Co., and that the company should be dismissed from the Complaint. Ford Storage & Moving Co. is on notice that no additional waivers will be granted for future latefiled annual fee payments and failure to remit future annual fee payments in a timely manner could result in administrative fines and costs.

Based on the above, the Commission finds that National Health Transport; American Eagle Van Lines, Inc.; and Ford Storage & Moving Co. should be dismissed from the Complaint.
