BY THE COMMISSION:

On October 7, 2002, National Motor Freight Traffic Association, Inc., Alexandria, Virginia, agent for and on behalf of participating carriers, filed an application for authority to place in effect on Nebraska intrastate traffic the provisions of Supplement 6 to the National Motor Freight Classification, NMF 100-AB.

Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on October 9, 2002, pursuant to the Commission's rules. The application is not protested.

According to the Applicant, Supplement 6 is issued for the purpose of listing participants whose participation has been cancelled from the National Motor Freight Classification. Supplement 6 does not cancel the participation of any Nebraska based carriers.

Upon consideration of the application and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that National Motor Freight Traffic Association, Inc., Alexandria, Virginia, agent for and on behalf of participating carriers, be, and it is hereby, authorized to place in effect on Nebraska intrastate traffic the provisions of Supplement 6 to the National Motor Freight Classification, NMF 100-AB.

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

