## BY THE COMMISSION:

On January 28, 2003, the Nebraska Public Service Commission (Commission), on its own motion, initiated this investigation to examine the development of a uniform range in household goods mover rates and to develop procedures to efficiently process household goods mover tariff amendments. The Commission established an annual review process to determine whether any adjustment is to be made in the household goods movers Tariffs 7F and 22, which includes to mailing of affidavits to all certificated household goods movers.

On May 3, 2017, a hearing was held to determine whether any adjustments should be made to each tariff for 2017. In its June 22, 2017 Order, the Commission did not implement any changes to the tariffs, and stated that it would determine in another proceeding whether major changes to the Tariff 7F and Tariff 22 should be undertaken. On September 28, 2017, the Commission opened docket MR-1020/PI-210 to seek input from the industry regarding any major changes to each tariff.

Based on the above, the Commission finds that the annual schedule to determine any changes to the Official Household Goods Tariff 7F and Official Intracity Household Goods Tariff 22 that has previously been undertaken in this docket shall be postponed for 2018. No affidavits will be mailed to certificated carriers at this time. Any adjustments to each tariff for 2018 shall be discussed in the recently opened tariff docket.

## ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the 2018 tariff review schedule be, and is hereby, postponed pending action in docket MR-1020/PI-210.
