OPPINION AND FINDINGS

On September 26, 2003, National Motor Freight Traffic Association, Inc., Alexandria, Virginia, agent for and on behalf of participating carriers, filed an application for authority to place in effect on Nebraska intrastate traffic the provisions of Supplement 7 to the National Motor Freight Classification, NMF 100-AC.

Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on September 29, 2003, pursuant to the Commission's rules. The application was not protested.

Supplement 7 is issued to identify carriers whose participation in the National Motor Freight Classification has been cancelled. Supplement 7 cancels the participation of Abler Transfer Inc., Norfolk and R & R Xpress Inc., Falls City.

Upon consideration of the application and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the National Motor Freight Traffic Association, Inc., Alexandria, Virginia, agent for and on behalf of participating carriers, be, and it is hereby, authorized to place in effect on Nebraska intrastate traffic the provisions of Supplement 7 to the National Motor Freight Classification, NMF 100-AC.
