OPPINION AND FINDINGS

On October 31, 2003, National Motor Freight Traffic Association, Inc., Alexandria, Virginia, agent for and on behalf of participating carriers, filed an application for authority to place in effect on Nebraska intrastate traffic the provisions of Supplement 10 to the National Motor Freight Classification, NMF 100-AC.

Emergency action is requested.

Supplement 10 is issued for the purpose of adding participants and/or re-instating participants in the National Motor Freight Classification. Supplement 10 does not affect any Nebraska carriers.

Upon consideration of the application and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application should be granted.




