OPINION AND FINDINGS

On December 30, 2003, National Motor Freight Traffic Association, Inc., Alexandria, Virginia, agent for and on behalf of participating carriers, filed an application for authority to place in effect on Nebraska intrastate traffic the provisions of Supplement 1 to the National Motor Freight Classification, NMF 100-AD.

Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on January 2, 2004, pursuant to the Commission's rules. The application was not protested.

The authority to place in effect the provisions contained in National Motor Freight Classification, NMF 100-AD, on Nebraska intrastate traffic was granted by the Commission on December 16, 2003, pursuant to Application No. MR-1018. The Applicant now seeks the authority to place in effect the provisions of Supplement 1 to NMF 100-AD on Nebraska intrastate traffic.

Included in the application is an appendix to Supplement 1 to NMF 100-AD that provides a numeric directory of amendments to the National Motor Freight Classification (NMFC) published in the Supplement. The directory lists 192 separate amendments of which 40 are identified as a new item or new package. Additionally, the index provides the written justifications and explanations of the National Classification Committee (NCC) for each change.

Upon consideration of the application and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that National Motor Freight Traffic Association, Inc., Alexandria, Virginia, agent for and on behalf of participating carriers, be, and it is hereby, authorized to place in effect on Nebraska intrastate traffic the provisions of Supplement 1 to the National Motor Freight Classification, NMF 100-AD.
