OPINION AND FINDINGS

On October 30, 2000, National Motor Freight Association, Inc., Alexandria, Virginia, agent for and on behalf of participating carriers, filed an application for authority to place in affect on Nebraska intrastate traffic the provisions of Supplement 8 to the National Motor Freight Classification Tariff, NMF 100-Z.

Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on November 2, 2000, pursuant to the Commission's rules. The application is unopposed.

According to the Applicant, Supplement 8 was issued for the purpose of adding carriers and/or re-instating carriers as participants in the National Motor Freight Classification. In the ICC Termination Act of 1995, Congress included an enforceable participation requirement. Accordingly, motor carriers who use or refer to any provisions of the National Motor Freight Classification in their contracts, rate schedules or tariffs to determine rates or charges must be bona fide participants in the Classification.

The list of new or re-instated carrier participants does not include any Nebraska based carriers.

Upon consideration of the application and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application should be granted effective October 28, 2000.

ORDER

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that effective October 28, 2000, National Motor Freight Association, Inc., Alexandria, Virginia, agent for and on behalf of participating carriers, be, and it is hereby, authorized to place in affect on Nebraska intrastate traffic the provisions of Supplement 8 to the National Motor Freight Classification Tariff, NMF 100-Z.




