OPINION AND FINDINGS

On December 8, 2000, National Motor Freight Association, Inc., Alexandria, Virginia, agent for and on behalf of participating carriers, filed an application for authority to place in effect on Nebraska intrastate traffic the provisions of Supplement 1 to the National Motor Freight Classification, NMF 100-AA

Emergency action is requested.

According to the applicant, Supplement 1 is issued for the purpose of adding carriers and/or re-instating carriers as participants in the National Motor Freight Classification. In the ICC Termination Act of 1995, Congress included an enforceable participation requirement. Accordingly, motor carriers who use or refer to any provisions of the National Motor Freight Classification in their contracts, rate schedules or tariffs to determine rates or charges must be bona fide participants in the Classification. Supplement 1 is issued on one day notice.

The list of new or re-instated carrier participants does not include an Nebraska based carriers.

Upon consideration of the application and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application should be granted effective December 13, 2000.

ORDER

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that effective December 13, 2000, National Motor Freight Association, Inc., Alexandria, Virginia, agent for and on behalf of participating carriers, be, and it is hereby, authorized to place in effect on Nebraska intrastate traffic the provisions of Supplement 1 to the National Motor Freight Classification, NMF 100-AA.
