OPINION AND FINDINGS

On November 13, 2001, National Motor Freight Traffic Association, Inc., Alexandria, Virginia, agent for and on behalf of participating carriers, filed an application for authority to place in effect on Nebraska intrastate traffic the provisions of Supplement 6B to the National Motor Freight Classification, NMF 1-AA.

Emergency action is requested.

According to the Applicant, Supplement 6B is issued for the purpose of adding participants and or re-instating participants in the National Motor Freight Classification. This supplement adds 12 motor carriers to its list of participating carriers. The list of additional carriers includes one Nebraska based motor carrier (Kastens, Jerry L., Otoe, NE).

The application is filed in compliance with Section 75-308 (Rates) and 75-121 (Emergency rate orders), R.R.S. 1996 and the Commission rules.

Upon consideration of the application and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application should be granted on an emergency basis effective November 21, 2001.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska public Service Commission that effective November 21, 2001, National Motor Freight Traffic Association, Inc., Alexandria, Virginia, agent
