OPINION AND FINDINGS

Pursuant to a hearing held March 28, 1995, the Commission entered its order in the this matter May 16, 1995, in which it ordered that each of the 44 carriers of general commodities who have expressed an interest in holding a certificate of public convenience and necessity be interviewed by Commission investigators to gather information upon which the Commission could decide whether to grant the authority. The interviews having been completed and submitted to the Commission, the Commission finds that:

1. Ample evidence was furnished during the interviews so that the following named carriers should be granted certificates of public convenience and necessity to operate in Nebraska intrastate commerce in transportation of household goods in the same territories they served as general commodity carriers prior to the deregulation of motor carrier transportation except household goods and passengers:

2. The evidence adduced during the interviews was inadequate to establish that the following named carriers should be issued certificates of public convenience and necessity and they should be ordered to appear before the Commission and show cause why any authority to transport household goods they may have held under their general commodity authority should not be revoked for willful failure

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to perform transportation of household goods pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. 75-311 as amended by LB 424:

3. Those carriers listed in Paragraph 2 of these findings should be given notice and a hearing should be convened at which each of them may present evidence to support their requests that they be granted authority to operate as household goods carriers.

4. Certificates of public convenience and necessity should be issued to those carriers named in Paragraph 1 of these findings granting them authority to operate as carriers of household goods upon payment of annual fees, proof of insurance, and purchase of Tariff 7-E.

O R D E R

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that orders be entered in each carrier's file consistent with the foregoing findings.
