O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

Relator Wayne F. Rowe alleges in his petition that the Respondents Mayflower Contract Services, Inc., John Doe and John Doe's un-named organization, Happy Cab, Checker Cab, and Yellow Cab have conducted intrastate common carrier service to and from Eppley Airport, Omaha, Nebraska which may have violated the statutes and rules of the Commission.

Respondents Mayflower Contract Services, Inc., Happy Cab, Yellow Cab, and Checker Cab currently possess certificates of authority from this Commission to conduct certain intrastate operations. Respondent John Doe and John Doe's un-named organization are not alleged to hold a certificate of authority.

Relator's petition questions whether these certificated carriers and John Doe and his un-named organization are in violation the Motor Carrier Act or the Commission's rules and regulations which govern intrastate motor common carriers.

We find that an investigation should be conducted to determine the facts alleged in the petition. Accordingly, the petition should be granted and a hearing be held in this matter.

IT IS ORDERED that the petition be granted and that a hearing on this petition be held with evidence presented and arguments made as to whether the intrastate carriage operations of Mayflower Contract Services, Inc. and John Doe and his un-named organization were in violation of the State Motor Carrier Act or the Commission's motor carrier rules and regulations and whether there were service failures by Happy Cab, Yellow Cab, and Checker Cab which would warrant further action by the Commission.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Respondents be given notice of the hearing on this petition, the date on which it is to be held, and a copy of the petition.
