COMES NOW THE RELATOR, Wayne F. Rowe, on behalf of the Commission's Transportation Department and, pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. 75-111 (Reissue 1990) and Nebraska Admin. Reg. Title 291, Ch. 1, Rule 012 et seq., petitions the Commission to order a hearing and determine whether the intrastate motor carrier operations conducted by Mayflower Contract Services, Inc. (B-1275); Happy Cab Co. (dba Happy Cab (B-1215), Yellow Cab (B-1122), and Checker Cab (B-1121)); John Doe; and John Doe's un-named business to and from Eppley Airfield, Omaha, Nebraska, from on or about the period of October 25, 1991 to October 30, 1991 were in violation of the Nebraska Motor Carrier Act and or the Commission's Motor Carrier rules and regulations.

In support of the petition, Relator alleges:

- 1. Respondent Mayflower Contract Services, Inc. provided drivers and buses to transport arriving and departing conventioneers at Eppley Airfield, Omaha, Nebraska on or about the dates cited above in conjunction with a contractual arrangement between itself, and Respondents John Doe, and John Doe's organization. Said organization apparently sponsored the convention in question.
- 2. Drivers of Respondent Happy Cab Company's taxi services boycotted Eppley Airfield in protest of the above-described operations while the Mayflower buses operated at Eppley.

WHEREFORE, Relator prays the Commission set this matter for hearing, serve notice on the Respondents, and determine whether any violations have occurred. If the Commission, after the hearing on this petition, finds that the Respondents are in violation of the Motor Carrier Act, Relator requests as an immediate remedy that the Commission issue an order to Respondents that they cease and desist from operating in violation of the Act or Commission rules and regulations; and further that it revoke or suspend the authorities of the Respondents holding certificates of authority from this Commission. Relator additionally requests that the Commission seek criminal prosecution against John Doe and his organization in the local court, if the findings so warrant.
