## BY THE COMMISSION:

The Nebraska Public Service Commission (Commission) hereby opens the above-captioned docket, on its own motion, to determine the annual fee to be paid by Transportation Network Companies (TNCs) as required pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 75-305(2). Section 75-305(2) requires TNCs to pay an annual fee of either twenty-five thousand dollars or not to exceed eighty dollars for each personal vehicle operated by a driver of the TNC. The statute also provides that "the commission shall establish the amount per vehicle..."

Based on the above, the Commission finds that a hearing should be scheduled to determine the amount of the annual fee necessary to sustain the administration and enforcement of laws, rules, and regulations governing TNCs. Therefore, the Commission sets this matter for public hearing on Wednesday, November 18, 2015, at 10:00 a.m., in the Commission Hearing Room, 300 The Atrium Building, 1200 N Street, Lincoln, Nebraska.
