### OPINION AND FINDINGS

On March 9, 2005, Daniel W. and Susan L. Sindt d/b/a Kearney Cab Company, Kearney, Nebraska, filed an application for authority to amend its rates for its operations as follows:

Description	Current	Proposed
1. First 1/5 mile (initial meter charge)	\$2.25	\$2.50
2. Each additional 1/5 mile or fraction thereof	\$0.25	\$0.30
3. Each additional passenger and/or baggage	\$0.75	\$0.75
4. Waiting time per minute	\$0.30	\$0.30
5. Refusal of ordered service upon arrival of taxicab at point of commencement of trip.	\$2.25	\$2.25

Emergency action is requested.

Applicant is a certificated common carrier which holds Certificate B-1402. The certificate authorizes the transportation of passengers by taxicab between points in Buffalo County and between points within Buffalo County, on the one hand, and, on the other hand, points in Nebraska over irregular routes. The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized.

In support of the application, Daniel Sindt of Kearney Cab states that fuel charges and insurance costs have increased dramatically. Prices in his area have increased towards \$2.10 per gallon in the last few weeks.

The cost of gasoline has continued to increase, reaching nearly \$2.10 per gallon average in Nebraska as of the time of this order. The increase in cost to the applicant is significant, and needs to be addressed quickly to protect the applicant's ability to continue to provide its services to the public.

Upon consideration of the application and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application should be granted on an emergency basis effective March 24, 2005.

ORDER

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that effective March 24, 2005, Daniel W. and Susan L. Sindt d/b/a Kearney Cab, Kearney, Nebraska, be, and it is hereby, authorized to amend its rates for its use in Certificate No. B-1402 as follows:

3. Each additional passenger and/or baggage	\$0.75
4. Waiting time per minute	\$0.30
5. Refusal of ordered service upon arrival of taxicab at point of commencement of trip.	\$2.25
