BY THE COMMISSION:

On April 29, 2014, Servant Cab Company LLC dba Yellow Cab Company and Capital Cab Company, of Lincoln, Nebraska, filed an application for authority to amend its taxi rates for transportation between points in Lincoln and a 25 mile radius thereof as follows:

Emergency action is requested.

OPINION AND FINDINGS

Applicant is a certified common carrier which holds Certificate B-1581. The Certificate authorizes the transportation of passengers by taxicab between points in Lincoln and a 25 mile radius thereof.

The Applicant is requesting that the rate structure be adjusted to include the charge for any individual, group, business or governmental entity which purchases Ten (10) or more trips in a single day to be charged at \$38.00 per trip, with a \$2.00 per mile charge for any mileage over five miles.

The Applicant cites that the Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) will reimburse them at this amount and that the proposed rates will allow them to take advantage of this rate.

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After consideration of the application as set forth by the Applicant, the Commission is of the opinion and hereby finds that this proposed rate cannot be approved without additional information being adduced. While the Commission notes the factors set out in the application, more information must be received regarding this proposed rate before the Commission enters a final order in this application.

Upon consideration of the application, the evidence adduced and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application should be denied on an emergency basis. The Commission further finds that the Application should be processed pursuant to Commission Rules regarding rate applications.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the application is denied on an emergency basis, that the Application is to be processed according to Commission rules

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that public notice of this action be published in the Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, pursuant to the provisions of Section 75-121, R.R.S. 2013, and the Commission's Rules.
