OPININON AND FINDINGS

On December 29, 2014, Nebraska Taxi, LLC, Lexington, Nebraska, filed an application for authority to establish rates for its use in its operations as follows:

Emergency action is requested.

Applicant is a certificated common carrier which holds Certificate Number B-1880. The certificate allows the transportation of passengers by taxicab in Dawson County, on the one hand, and, on the other hand, points in Nebraska over irregular routes. The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized. HHS Designation: Yes.

The Applicant received authority to operate from the Commission under Certificate No. B-1880, on October 15, 2014. The Applicant is establishing rates for these particular vehicles for use in this certificate.

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The Applicant represents to the Commission that the proposed rates are based upon its anticipated operating expenses and is designed to allow it to earn a reasonable operating profit.

In applications such as these, the Commission must find that an emergency situation exists. Such a situation exists in this application as the Applicant cannot begin operations under its certificate as granted until the rates are approved.

Upon consideration of the application and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application should be granted on an emergency basis effective January 9, 2015.

ORDER

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that effective January 9, 2015, Nebraska Taxi, LLC, Lexington, Nebraska, be, and it is hereby, authorized to establish rates for its authority for the as follows:
