## **TITLE 17 – NEBRASKA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION – AERONAUTICS DIVISION**

### **Chapter 4 – Transmission Lines**

001 Upon the filing of an application for permission to construct or alter any overhead wire, cable or pipeline as provided in Neb. Rev. Statute §75-713, the Aeronautics Division of the Nebraska Department of Transportation shall review the application and transmit its approval or disapproval to the Public Service Commission

002 The requirement which must be met by an applicant to obtain approval is as follows:

002.01 The wire, cable, or pipeline must not be an obstruction as defined in Federal Aviation Regulations (FAR) Part 77 “Objects Affecting Navigable Airspace” published January 1975, and;

002.02 The wire, cable, or pipeline must not violate any local zoning regulations or the local zoning board must agree to waive the local regulation.

003 When a proposed structure is near an airport, the Division may require the applicant to furnish an FAA determination in regards to FAR Part 77. An FAA determination can be obtained by submitting a FAA Form 7460-1 to the appropriate FAA office.
